TRAINING LOCATION and ACCOMMODATION: Central Manchester

COST: This three day residential programme is being held with a grant from the Churchill Fellowship and will be free of charge for all participants.

What is the BASNET Capacity Building Programme?

The BASNET three-day Residential Capacity Building Programme holding in Manchester from 15 to 18 November 2022 will focus on building successful leadership and management skills needed to be an effective UK anti-trafficking innovator. It will convene a diverse cohort of 15 participants who are members of the UK BME Anti- Slavery Network. The programme will empower Black and ethnic founders and CEOs in the UK modern slavery sector to grow their organisations and strengthen their ability to create lasting change in their communities. The programme will cover the following topics:

Learning from a Range of Experts in the Field

Build your leadership and management skills learning from a range of experts. Understand how to create lasting change in your community while gaining new skills.

Professional 1 : 1 Coaching and Support

Provision of 1 : 1 coaching sessions during and after programme to support participants to accelerate and further embed their learning and development. Sessions will use coaching and peer reviews to unpick strengths and areas of development in leadership.

Sessions will also support leaders as they take newfound skills and insights and apply them to their work

Leadership and Organisational Development Themed Sessions

Powerful experiential learning and sharing with other anti-trafficking leader-innovators about "what works". Exploring leadership in the UK anti-trafficking sector, building collaborations and partnerships. How to build beyond generations while raising sustainable funds and communicating with impact

Developing a Range of New Skills, Knowledge, and Capacity

Learn long-term planning to develop your organisation's strategic footprint. Improve your skills in building a theory of change and measuring impact to build positive results and outcomes and enhance your contributions towards lasting change in the UK anti-trafficking sector.

WHAT CAN YOU EXPECT?

The BASNET Residential Capacity Building Programme aims to foster networking between members and aid the strengthening of skills to advance their organisations. Over three days, 15 innovators would network and share learning and experiences about their anti-trafficking work, successes and challenges. There would be an opportunity to learn from two successful innovators who founded and led mainstream anti-trafficking charities for many years. Fundraising experts would coach and train participants on how to produce strong fundraising proposals, theory of change and develop strong monitoring and evaluation tools to measure the success of their work. Additionally, there will be a focus on strategic planning to enable participants gain the skills to plan long-term for their work, tackling internal weakness and external threats they may face. The last part of the programme would entail participants learning how to strengthen their messaging, ensuring they are able to communicate their work to others in the sector and in their communities, demonstrating impact.

- Applicants must be able to dedicate time to attend the three full day programme from 15 to 18 November 2022
